I	Infectious and parasitic diseases
II	Neoplasms (tumors)
III	Diseases of the blood and blood-forming organs and certain disorders involving the immune mechanism
IV	Endocrine, nutritional and metabolic diseases
V-VIII	Mental and behavioral disorders (V) and Diseases of the nervous system and of the sensory organs (VI-VIII).
IX	Diseases of the circulatory system
X	Diseases of the respiratory system
XI	Diseases of the digestive system
XII	Diseases of the skin and subcutaneous tissue
XIII	Diseases of the musculoskeletal system and the connective tissue
XIV	Diseases of the genitourinary system
XV	Pregnancy, childbirth and the puerperium
XVI	Conditions originating in the perinatal period
XVII	Congenital malformations, deformations and chromosomal abnormalities.
XVIII	Symptoms, signs and abnormal clinical and laboratory findings, not elsewhere classified
XX	External causes of mortality
